PPI Agreement

 - a. Your treatment of that patient as defined under 45 CFR 164.501 and as allowed under 45 CFR 164.506(c)(2) or
 - b. Your payment activities related to that patient as defined under 45 CFR 164.501 and as allowed under 45 CFR 506(c)(3).
 - c. If you need access to PPI for your health care operations as defined under 45 CFR 164.501 and as allowed under 45 CFR 164.505(c)(4), please contact Customer Service for assistance.

You will comply with all applicable state and federal laws related to the confidentiality and security of PPI, including laws relating to the use and disclosure of such information.
